

Absent Members

12. Any member wishing to be absent from Singapore shall be at liberty to retain his/her membership by notifying the Guild in writing provided such absence shall not exceed 2 years. Such absent members are exempted from monthly subscriptions.

13. Any absent member on return shall at once resume membership and the monthly subscription payable shall be due from the beginning of the following month. In case his/her absence all exceed 3 years and no notice of extending the same shall have been given, he/she shall be considered resigned.

14. If any absent member, on return, having been written to for payment of subscription, fails to pay, such member shall be considered to have resigned, after a lapse of one month.

Ancestral
Worship

15. Customary Ancestral Worships shall be observed.

16. On each occasion of an Ancestral Worship, a dinner will be held. Any member, wishing to participate, shall pay a subscription towards such a dinner, the amount to be fixed and announced by the General Committee.

Management &
Officers

17. The management of the Guild shall be vested in a General Committee, composed of a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, an asst. Secretary, a Treasurer, an asst. Treasurer and 8 other Committee Members. All officers except the Treasurer may be re-elected year after year.

18. The General Committee shall be empowered to elect any member to fill up a vacancy in the General Committee before the next Annual General Meeting.

19. The General Committee shall meet Bi-monthly or as often as it may be deemed advisable. Six shall form a Quorum.

20. (a) The General Committee shall have the power to make bye-laws & to appoint Sub-Committees for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Guild, and delegate to the Sub-Committees such powers as they deem necessary.

(b) The General Committee shall have power to appoint District Superintendents to assist in its dealings with members living in their respective Districts.
