Prohibitions

- 37. (a) Gambling of any kind, whether for stakes or not, are forbidden on the Guild's premises. The introduction of materials for gambling or opium smoking & of bad characters into the premises is prohibited.
- (b) The funds of the Guild shall not be used to pay the finds of members who have been convicted in Court.
- (c) The Guild shall not attempt to restrict or in any other manner interfere with trade or prices or engage in any Trade Union activity as defined in the Trade Union Ordinance, 1940.
- (d) The Guild shall not hold any lottery whether confined to its members or not, in the name of the Guild or its office-bearers, committee or members.
- (e) The Guild shall not indulge in any political activity or allow its fund and/or premises to be used for political purposes.

Dissolution

- 38. (a) The Guild shall not be dissolved, except with the consent of not less than 3/5 of the members of the Guild, expressed either in person or by proxy at a General Meeting convened for the purpose, or by postal vote.
- (b) In the event of the Guild being dissolved as provided above, all debts and liabilities legally incurred on behalf of the Guild shall be fully discharged, and the remaining funds will be divided equally amongst members.
- (c) Notice of dissolution shall be given within 14 days of the dissolution to the Registrar of Societies.
